I primarily work in community-based clinics. And I play an integral role within the multi-disciplinary team in the management of lower limb wounds secondary to diseases such as diabetes and peripheral arterial disease.



I enjoy the opportunity for health education and promoting positive foot health behaviours. And empowering patients to develop positive daily habits that not only increases early detection of foot disease but can also reduce development of foot complications.
